



CURRY STUDENT SUCCESS FUND SCHOLARSHIP

The Curry Student Success Fund exists to offer scholarships and financial assistance to graduating high school students of private, Christian, home school, General Education Diploma (G.E.D.), or public school backgrounds, AND to graduated students seeking to continue in their educational pursuits. Awards are available to students pursuing education at a public/private college, trade school, training program, or certification program.

The mission of the Curry Student Success Fund is to promote educational opportunities and serve all students, including those excluded by local scholarship foundations because of alternative education choices.

Eligibility requirements for this scholarship are:

*Senior in high school eligible to graduate this year

OR *Post high school graduate registered for Fall term at either a college or trade school

OR *GED completed student registered for Fall term at either a college or trade school

NOTE: Only those pursuing an AA, Bachelor's, or certification program are eligible. NO Master's Degree or PhD applicants.

*Must have proof of acceptance into the school of choice for Fall term.

*Must be a resident of Curry County, OR.

*Application deadline is May 1, 2020.

An interview process will follow the application in the 3 weeks to follow, and awards will be announced in June 2019.

Scholarship money will be sent directly to the school.
